प्र.1 पर्यावरणीय पर्यटन (**Eco tourism**) से आप क्या समझते हैं?

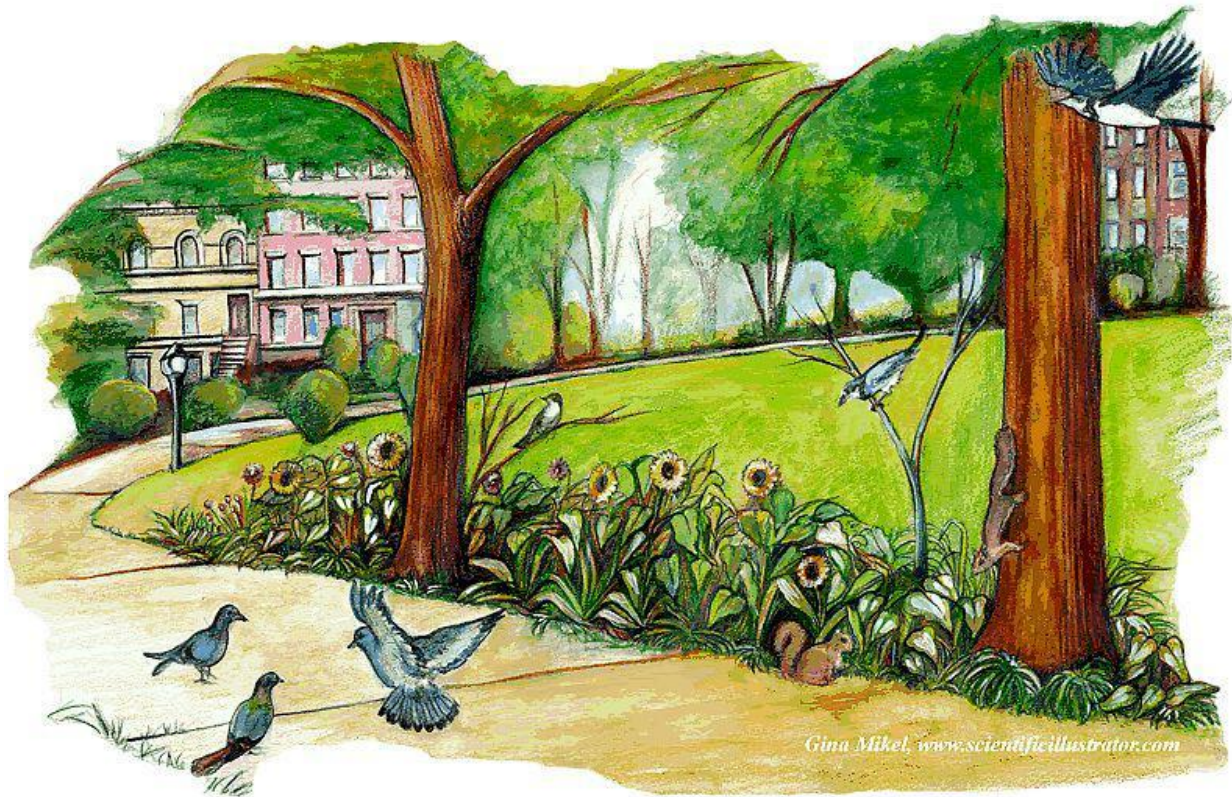

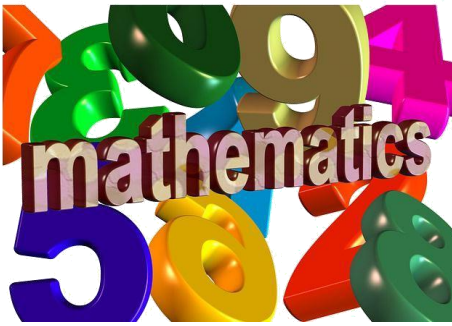
